What is the energy strategy in Kosovo?

The main policymaking documentin the energy sector in Kosovo is the Energy Strat-egy (hereafter: the Strategy). The Strategy is drafted by the Ministry of Economy, covers a period of ten years and has to identify the main challenges that the sector faces and outline the policies to develop the sector.

How secure is electricity supply in Kosovo?

Security of elec-tricity supply depends on a fleet of aged coal-fired power plants built between the 1960s and 1980s owned and operated by the Kosovo Energy Corporation, one of the bigest public enterprises in the country. The uptake of renewables has been slow with a limited number of support mea-sures in the last decade.

Electricity generation represents its main business, while its dominance in the sector has made it one of the most profitable state-owned enter-prises in Kosovo. Kosovo initially planned to develop new generation capacities, competitively con-tracting a private company to build and operate a lignite-fired power plant.
