How much do solar panels cost?

The price of solar panels changes depending on where you live, but the average for installation is just under \$29,000 or \$2.75 per watt. On the high end, we talked to a solar customer in Hawaii who spent \$100,000 going solar. Dion in Nevada said their 10-kW system cost about \$20,000, which is about the national average price for a 7-kW system.

How much does a residential solar system cost?

Using these numbers, an average-sized 8-kilowatt residential solar system would cost between \$21,900 - \$26,400. Regional pricing differences, the system size, local installation costs, inclusion of home battery backup, and local incentives are other factors which affect the final cost.

How much does a solar system cost per watt?

As of publishing, the average cost per watt is \$2.84. Most solar companies set the price according to the solar system's wattage. A solar installation's "cost per watt" is a little like the "price per square foot" when you buy a house. It helps compare the value of solar energy systems in different sizes.

How much does a commercial solar system cost?

Commercial solar systems cost 15-25% less per watt than home systems. Businesses usually see faster payback than homeowners because they use more power during daylight hours and can take advantage of tax benefits. Total cost before incentives: \$2.30-\$2.80 per watt (\$23,000-\$70,000)

What is included in the quoted price of a solar power system?

The quoted price of a solar power system also includes soft costs that are not evident when looking at a completed installation: permitting, inspections, grid interconnection, taxes, transportation, land acquisition, design work, skilled labor, customer acquisition, overhead, profit margins, etc.
